

Niagara Falls Camera Club 2017 Summer Inspiration Challenge

We know how hard it can be to get inspired to photograph something new and challenging. We have assembled a list of 6 areas to help inspire you that may be out of your normal comfort area. This is not a competition.

The rules are simple.

- Photograph each of the 6 subjects between now and October 1st.
- Shoot them in one day or use them as an opportunity to get out multiple times and do some photography.
- Once you have all 6 locations photographed, take your best shot from each location and resize them to 1920 x 1080.
- Save your images as JPGs
- Please name your with the location number and your name. Example “4 Chris Empey”
- Email those 6 images to cempey@NiagaraFallsCameraClub.org.
- All the submissions will then be compiled into a slideshow and will be shown at the November 6 meeting of the Niagara Falls Camera Club and will then be posted to YouTube and our website for online viewing.
- There is no cost to participate.
- Submissions are open to everyone, not only camera club members.



#1. Oakes Garden Theater

This is a large area and you are limited only by your creativity and the boundaries as outlined to the right.

GPS: 43.09043, -79.07223



#2. Niagara Falls Old Post Office/Police Station and downtown bridges.

This old building is an iconic piece of architecture in Niagara Falls, but don't forget to look beyond the building to the surround area. Again stay within the boundaries as outlined to the right.

GPS: 43.10767, -79.06186



#3. Lone Trees on Hwy 3

There are two trees that sit alone on this ridge.
Photograph them as you like but be mindful of the farmland between HWY 3 and the trees.
This is private property so you will be shooting the trees from the road (approximately 225 meters).

Directions: Take HWY 3 toward Wainfleet. The trees are on the right in a farmers fields as HWY 3 turns right toward Wainfleet

GPS: 42.89713, -79.36714



4. St. Mark's Anglican Church and Graveyard – Niagara On The Lake

Many old gravestones and a nice church to photograph here.

GPS: 43.25504, -79.06796



5. Your Home

The Niagara Falls Library serves as the home of the Niagara Falls Camera Club. For this portion of the challenge, instead of shooting in the NFCC home, we want you to make a photograph within your house. This would be a great rainy day challenge when you don't want to go outside.

6. Old Culverts on Chippawa Parkway

There are two old culverts on Chippawa Parkway, just east of Stanley Avenue that were never installed. Use these in your photograph somehow.

GPS: 43.049, -79.081
