CanAm Photo Expo 2019

The CanAm Photo Expo is the annual convention for the Niagara Frontier Regional Camera Clubs. Along with print and digital image salons, the Expo features hands on workshops, seminars, outings and presentations by leading industry photographers.

This years Expo will be held April 26-28 at the Buffalo Grand Hotel in Buffalo, NY. Seminar topics range from portraiture, nature, and travel to night photography, weddings, photo-journalism and also include software topics such as Photoshop and Topaz plugins.

There is also a large trade show with many vendors offering substantial discounts on gear.

Deborah Sandidge is a professional photographer, and Nikon Ambassador, specializing in world travel and artistic imagery.
